## BOLOGNA FESTIVAL

For over forty years, Bologna Festival has brought to its city the world's leading symphony orchestras, distinguished conductors, and renowned soloists from the contemporary international music scene.

Throughout the year, the Festival presents a series of high-calibre concert programmes such as *Grandi Interpreti*, dedicated to the core classical and romantic repertoire, *Talenti*, which highlights emerging artists on the European stage, and *Il Nuovo l'Antico l'Altrove*, which fosters dialogue between early and contemporary music while embracing cross-cultural influences.

*Baby BoFe'* is the Festival's educational initiative for children and young audiences aged 0-11. It is designed to engage families and schools through accessible and high-quality classical music experiences.

In addition, projects such as *Classica in sneakers*, *Carteggi Musicali*, *Musica a Palazzo Pepoli*, and *Note sul registro* extend the Festival's outreach by bringing music into a variety of cultural and social venues across the city — from museums and historical courtyards to informal breweries.
